You will need to complete an entry form, pay the entry fee, according to the guidelines listed below, no later than Friday, September 9, 2011 at 8:00pm. ***Then decorate a large coffee can that you provide***, with a slot in the lid to deposit money. You may decorate the can anyway you choose, but you should have the child's picture and name on the can in some way.

You may bring your completed entry form, entry fee, and decorated can to the Extension Office, 840 Chares Street, Wellsburg, WV 26070, before Thursday, September 8, 2011, or you may bring it to the 4-H tent at the Fairgrounds. In order to be eligible for prizes, you must have registered your baby and turned in a can no later than 8:00pm on Friday, September 9, 2011.

You may collect money on your own ahead of time or just let the public vote at the fair. The winner will be determined by the amount of votes (**\$0.25 per vote**) and a 1st place trophy will be presented to the winning baby on Sunday, September 11, 2011, 5:00pm. Note: you do not have to be present to win.
